# **Grading system**

The ECTS transcripts of records will be sent to the students by email and to their home university by email and regular mail. This transcript mentions the followed courses, the corresponding ECTS credits, the local grades (20 points) and the ECTS grades. Here, you can find our grading scale.

# **Registration procedure**

To study at EPHEC, students have to be officially **nominated** by their **home institution**, which must have signed a **student mobility agreement** with EPHEC.

Nominations should be sent by the International Coordinator of our partner institution to Mr Frédéric Simonis (f.simonis@ephec.be), together with the « Nomination form » duly completed.

The nomination deadlines are:

- 15 May for the Fall Semester (September January)
- 15 November for the Spring Semester (February June)
