In this crash-course on innovation and entrepreneurship students embark on a journey that takes them from a business idea to the development of a successful business plan.

Cross-cultural Management with a Global Perspective

A course to increase your effectiveness when interacting with people from other countries. At the end of the course you will be able to recognize, understand and take advantage of the most significant cultural differences in business and at the workplace.

A moral economy of sustainability & inequality

This course evaluates sustainability and social challenges from the perspective of a moral economy. It invites students to think morally about how individuals, companies and governments should approach the biggest challenges of our times such as climate change, degradation of ecosystem services, aporophobia, dismantling of welfare systems, the implications of artificial intelligence to labour markets and our social lives. It explores the links between people's moral sentiments and key social and economic institutions. This course examines the evidence behind key development issues from a moral perspective.

HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR COURSES?

- Each itinerary consists of different subjects. You must choose the itinerary that suits you best.
- All courses of a same itinerary have a completely compatible hour schedule.
- Once you have selected the itinerary, you will have to choose courses you want to be enrolled in:
 - a. Erasmus +: you need to enrol to a minimum of 30 ECTS.
 - b. Non - Erasmus +: you must be enrolled to a minimum of 24 ECTS.
- You will not be able to choose courses from different itineraries.
- Click to each course to access to the online syllabus.
- Besides your selection, all international students will be registered in *International Experience* equivalent to 1 ECTS. This course includes all activities organized by International Relations that are compulsory.
- The sending of your request does not imply the automatic allocation of places. The assignment will be confirmed by the staff of the office of International Relations through an email.
- Registration will be done in order of receipt of applications.
- Groups will be closed as soon as these are full.
- Exchange students must remain flexible as courses are never guaranteed due to prerequisites, classrooms capacity, time conflicts and class cancellations. IQS reserves the right to modify courses in the last minute in the interest of academic development.
- Every course that has any requirement or exception to the current rules, will be specified in each syllabus.
- For the Spanish course, a test will be done the first day of class in order to assign A1 and B1 levels.
