*Exchange students are required to live on-campus.	All exchange students are placed in residence halls that remain open during university breaks and that have kitchen facilities. These options can vary based on availability. Exchange students can be placed anywhere on-campus and usually live in the Quads, International House at Maxcy College (Maxcy), Bates-West or any of the Horseshoe apartments.
